## **Important Guidelines to help keep us all safe as we return to Worship Services. Praise God—we are back!!!**

1. **Hand sanitizer and masks** (should you need one) are provided in the foyer. An usher will be present at the front door for assistance.
2. **Attendance**—no more than 50 people at each services. Please be advised once 50 people have arrived we will not be able to receive more people in that service because of government guidelines
3. **Two services** one at 10 AM and the evening service at 6:30 PM  
**10:00 AM Service** will be attended by those 60 years of age and older. And may include some church leaders. Also .those that live further away can attend, even if you are younger than 60.  
**6:30 PM**—this service will include adults under the age of 60 and families.
4. **No children's church** at this time.
5. **Holy Communion** is served in both services on the 1st and 3rd Sunday.
6. **Seats in the sanctuary** are arranged with distances. Families, please seat yourselves on either side of the church. An usher will be available.
7. **Chairs in the sanctuary** will be disinfected before and after the service. Plus door knobs or anything that may be touched during our time of worship.
8. **Bibles and Hymn books** are removed temporarily for your safety. Please bring your own Bible. Choruses and hymns will be on the overhead.
9. **Offering**—the congregation will bring their offering to the altar to be placed in a designated offering plate.
10. For the time being **please refrain from hand shakes, hugs kisses and close body contact** while in the church. Please know you are never the less loved when avoiding these for now.
11. **Wednesday Night Sr. Youth Ministry and Bible school** will resume with these guidelines as well.
